

# JOSEPH INTERPRETS DREAMS

Old Testament Lesson #28

Things went well for Joseph as a slave in Potiphar's house. God blessed him, and he eventually became responsible for caring for Potiphar's entire household. Potiphar's wife fell in love with Joseph, but he rejected her because she was already married. In response, she tricked her husband into thinking Joseph had done something bad. Potiphar placed Joseph in prison (see Genesis 39:1-23).

Though Joseph was wrongly imprisoned, God continued to bless him. He found favor with the prison warden, who eventually put him in charge of all the prisoners. Two fellow prisoners, who had been the servants of Pharaoh, had dreams that made them sad. They told Joseph about the dreams.

The imprisoned cupbearer dreamed of a grapevine with three branches. The grapes were squeezed into a cup and given to Pharaoh. Joseph said the dream meant that the cupbearer would be restored to his position in Pharaoh's court after three days. Joseph requested that when the cupbearer left prison, he would remember and help Joseph.

The imprisoned baker explained that in his dream he carried on his head three baskets of bread. The top basket contained baked goods for Pharaoh, but the birds ate them. Joseph indicated that the three baskets also represented three days' time. However, unlike the cupbearer, the baker would not be restored to his position, but be hanged instead.

The dreams came true just as Joseph had said. Sadly though, when the cupbearer was restored to his position, he did not try to help Joseph.

#### **POINTS TO CONSIDER:**

- Joseph had interpreted dreams long before his imprisonment. Much earlier, he interpreted his own dreams regarding his family (Genesis 37:5-11). Those dreams were not fulfilled until later in Joseph's life, when his family came and bowed before him in Egypt (see events of Genesis 42-45).
- A cupbearer was a person in the household who tasted the wine before passing it to the people at the table. It was an important and honored position, one that had frequent access to the king.
