

Family Lesson for Reformation


Read **Mark 12:28-34** for the two most important of the 10 Commandments.
The first is...Love the Lord your God with all your heart, soul, mind and strength.

The second is...Love your neighbor as yourself.

The focus today is on the second commandment.

Below are 6 circles each one representing groups of people who are our "neighbors."

As you look at each group, discuss ways in which you can show them your love.



To make your own 6 circles, use any household round items such as cups and bowls to make your circles.

Next, write names of people in each group in the circle of that group.

After writing the names, write ways in which you can show love to those people.

Discuss with family and then share your love.

Remember that everyone, everywhere is our neighbor!

"Show Your Love Light" Craft

Materials:

Construction paper (3" lengthwise strip in any color)
White paper (1 piece letter size)
Tea Light (1LED)
Platform for Tea Light (a small Dixie cup works well)
Scotch tape (regular or invisible)
Scissors
Markers (various colors-washable)

Directions:



Cut a 3" lengthwise strip from the construction paper.

Take the white letter size sheet and tape it lengthwise onto the construction strip leaving some construction paper on either side of the white letter size sheet.

Turn it over so the taped side is away from you.



With the markers, write caring words, make designs, or anything that will remind you of today's lesson.



Curl the whole sheet into a cylinder and tape together at the seams (*you may need two people for this part.*)



Turn the platform to the flat side (Dixie cup upside down) and place the tea light onto it.



Take the cylinder and place it over the tea light/platform.
