

The Sunday School Lesson for this week is from Mark 13:1-8

- After reading the Bible story, you'll want to have one or two old items/pictures and a new one or two items/pictures. You'll share these items/pictures with family/group members to show how everything eventually wears out/falls apart.
- Discuss, as in the Bible passage, how Jesus shared this with His disciples. He knew they needed to realize, as we do now, that making things important in our lives would become pretty confusing and scary if they fell apart at same time.
- Jesus was teaching the disciples that if they focus on God instead of things, they would be paying attention to God's wisdom.
- Focusing on God would help them, and us now, to know the best way to do what's best for them/us and others.

Directions:


Cut poem out if using this template.


Glue template to the middle of background.
